

Remove the PCV hose by pinching the clamp and pulling the hose off. Next remove the 14mm bracket bolt. The smaller hole below it will be used as an alignment hole for the lower bracket screw. Also note that this hole is not threaded.




Assemble the bracket. 5mm Allen (hex) shorter screw goes into #1 as a dowel. Longer screw goes into #2 but don't tighten yet.





Use the factory 14mm bolt to attach the bracket.




Now put the can all the way in and tighten the bracket hoop screw with a 5mm Allen (hex) wrench.





Now put the can in and tighten the bracket hoop screw with a 5mm Allen (hex) wrench.
