Remove the plastic wire loom holders by pulling them straight off the threaded stud.




Next place the supplied custom bracket on them and secure it with the supplied 10mm flanged nuts. Then place the wire loom back in place.





Now assemble the catch can and hoses. The 10.75" length hose goes to the OUT fitting on the catch can. The 13" hose goes to the IN fitting on the catch can. Then attach the two 90° billet fittings as shown.




Now carefully remove the OE PCV hose by carefully pushing in on the tabs shown below and pulling it straight off. Store in a safe place.






Exposed PCV fittings.



Now attach the catch can to the bracket with the two supplied stainless steel 4mm Allen screws. Now attach the 90° billet fittings to the PCV fittings on the car. Be sure to push them all the way down.





Attach the circlips as shown. Make sure they go all the way in. Tug on each fitting to ensure its secure.



Install complete. Simply unscrew the base every 3-6 months to empty or use the 1/8th NPT drain plug.
