




Loosen the intercooler by removing these bolts.



Unclip the charge pipe by pulling this clip up and carefully lifting up on the intercooler and set it aside to expose the PCV hose.



Remove the factory PCV hose by squeezing the factory clamps with pliers. These will be reused to attach the custom BMS silicone hoses to the PCV system.







Remove the factory nuts and put the lower half of the BMS bracket on with the included nuts.



Then attach the upper bracket to the front of the 4 bolts on the top of BMS catch can and then bolt the upper bracket and can to the lower bracket with the included bolts.





Now connect the hoses using the factory clams on the engine and intake manifold. Pay special attention to which hoses are in and out. The BMS catch can in labeled on the top.



Put the intercooler and charge pipe back in and be sure the charge pipe clip snaps into place. Check all bolts.

Install complete! Empty the can every 3-6 months.
